**Madison...** Scholarship applications are currently being accepted for the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Joan Ballweg Leadership Scholarship. This year's deadline is Friday, April 3, 2020.

Eligibility is open to all graduating seniors who reside in the 41<sup>st</sup> Assembly District and are continuing their education in a 2-year technical college program or a 4-year baccalaureate degree program. Students must be graduating with at least a 3.0 average on a 4.0 point scale and must reside in the district. If you are unsure whether or not you reside in the 41<sup>st</sup> Assembly District, you can visit the legislature's website at [www.legis.wisconsin.gov](http://www.legis.wisconsin.gov). Type in your address under "Find My Legislators" to determine your home district.
