MADISON – The following is a statement from Rep. Tip McGuire on Gov. Evers' State of the State address:

“Working families are the backbone of this great state, and tonight Gov. Evers showed again that he is committed to leading on the issues that matter most to Wisconsinites: closing the Dark Store Loophole, bringing down the cost of prescription drugs, and addressing the looming student debt crisis.”
