MADISON - Today, Governor Tony Evers announced that a Safer at Home order would be released tomorrow and go into effect within the next 72 hours, requiring Wisconsinites to stay at home except for essential travel. Rep. Greta Neubauer released the following statement in support:

“This is an important next step in keeping our community safe and healthy through the COVID-19 pandemic. These decisions are never easy, but if we all can limit our travel to only the most essential trips and limit our contact to our households, Wisconsin can flatten the curve. Together, we can keep our vulnerable neighbors and essential workers safer from COVID-19.
