[Madison, WI] – Senate Majority Leader Scott Fitzgerald released the following statement following a ruling from the 7th Circuit Court of Appeals in DNC v Bostelmann:

“This ruling is a huge win for preserving the integrity of our election process in Wisconsin. Elections are decided on Election Day, period. Having ballots flow into clerk’s offices all over the state for days following Election Day is a preposterous setup that would completely undermine confidence in our state’s election processes.
