

Sen. LeMahieu: Appoints 2021-22 Finance Committee members

Madison – *Today, Senate Majority Leader-elect Devin LeMahieu (R-Oostburg) announced his Senate Republican appointees to the Legislature’s Joint Committee on Finance (JFC) for the 2021-22 Session of the Legislature.
