MADISON – Today, Senator-elect Melissa Agard (D-Madison) announced her staff in the Capitol office for the 2021-22 legislative session.

Aaron Collins will serve as Senator Agard's Chief of Staff. Aaron most recently worked for Assembly Democratic Leader Gordon Hintz (D-Oshkosh) as his Communications Director. He has worked in the state legislature and other roles in Wisconsin state government since 2010 including a stint at UW System leading their digital communications department. Previously, she served as the Legislative Assistant to Representative Chris Taylor and the 76th Assembly District. Megan Wittman was announced as Senator Agard's Outreach Director. She has served as a Legislative Assistant in Agard's State Assembly office since August 2020 after beginning her tenure as a legislative intern. Previously, she worked at the Wisconsin Institute for Discovery. Megan is a second generation immigrant.
