Madison, WI - Margaret Wrenn Hickey and Odalo J. Ohiku have accepted nominations to run for 2021 [State Bar of Wisconsin](#) president-elect.

Both candidates are lawyers in Milwaukee. Hickey is a shareholder with [Becker, Hickey & Poster, S.C.](#); Ohiku is deputy city attorney with the Milwaukee [Office of the City Attorney](#).

The election is held in April 2020. The president-elect serves a one-year term before becoming president on July 1, 2022.

The candidates are nominated by the State Bar Nominating Committee. Committee members were appointed by State Bar President Kathleen Brost. Cheryl Daniels is the Bar's current State Bar president-elect. She will succeed Brost as president on July 1, 2021.
