

U.S. Sen. Johnson: Discusses committee investigation on Hannity

"Take a look at the Bidens, the way they've been following the vice president around Hoovering up cash all around the world. I would think that represents a pretty strong potential conflict of interest, extortion, and counterintelligence risks that we simply can't ignore."

"We were just following the money. We were looking at all these financial transactions that should raise all kinds of concerns throughout America, and particularly in the mainstream media. So, the question really is ... is the mainstream media going to start asking questions and demanding answers from the vice president?"

"Take what they were alleging Donald Trump did - all false allegations - and then look at the Biden family. It's an order of magnitude worse. Many, many orders of magnitude worse."
