John Bolton, former national security adviser to President Trump and ambassador to the United Nations under President George W. Bush, will be the featured speaker for the Wisconsin Institute for Public Policy and Service's [Public Issues Series](#) on October 21 at 7 p.m. via Zoom. Bolton will speak on "Populism, National Security and U.S. Foreign Policy in Uncertain Times."

A long-time conservative, Bolton has served as a political consultant, media commentator, diplomat, and emerged as a key figure in the impeachment proceedings of President Trump. He continues to be a frequent media contributor on matters related to the Trump Administration.

Bolton's latest book, "The Room Where It Happened: A White House Memoir," sold 780,000 copies in the first week after its release on June 23.
