

# Wisconsin Institute for Law & Liberty: Statement on state Supreme Court decision

The Wisconsin Supreme Court issued [a decision](#) in *Legislature v. Palm* that strikes down the extension of the 'Safer at Home' order that locked down the state of Wisconsin in response to the coronavirus. WILL President and General Counsel Rick Esenberg issued the following statement:

*"The Court's decision ensures that Wisconsin's response to COVID-19 must involve both the executive and the legislative branch. Wisconsin will be better for it. The grave nature of the pandemic cannot be used to subvert our very form of government."*
