MADISON - Wisconsin Manufacturers & Commerce (WMC) President & CEO Kurt Bauer released the following statement after the Wisconsin Supreme Court struck down Emergency Order #28 - which extended the state's Safer at Home order - as unlawful, invalid and unenforceable:

"We commend the state Supreme Court for upholding the rule of law and understanding that coequal branches of government must work together, especially in times of crisis.
