

# WisGOP: Trump nominates Amy Coney Barrett for Supreme Court vacancy

[Madison, WI] – On Saturday, President Donald Trump nominated Judge Amy Coney Barrett for the vacancy on the Supreme Court of the United States. Following the announcement, the Republican Party of Wisconsin released the following statement from Chairman Andrew Hitt:
