WAUSAU, WI - In a rare Saturday session of the House of Representatives, Rep. Tom Tiffany [voted against H.R. 8015](#), the Delivering for America Act, a bill with strong bi-partisan support. This legislation ensures protection of the United States Postal Service with emergency funding.

WI-07 Democratic Candidate Tricia Zunker released the following statement in response:

“The U.S. Postal Service is a critical lifeline to many people throughout Wisconsin. The Trump administration has undertaken efforts to sabotage the U.S. Postal Service for political gain.
