

# All On The Line: Wisconsin's new maps must be fair & free from gerrymandering

Today, the Census Bureau released apportionment data based on the 2020 census count that determines the number of seats each state in the country has in the United States House of Representatives. **Based on this new data, Wisconsin will retain its eight congressional seats.**
