Ashland County Board Supervisor Laura Nagro will be holding virtual listening sessions to hear from constituents about the services they wish to see funded, issues affecting the county, and the upcoming Spring Referendum in April.

"Services in our county are in jeopardy. Over the last decade, the legislative folks in Madison have put more and more unfunded obligations on rural counties. Couple that with our decreasing ability to create revenue, continued patterns of spending, and you get a crisis. We do not have the tax base to continue supporting everything and tough decisions are past due," said Nagro, "The buck needs to stop here. I do not feel one listening session is enough on something so important, so I am providing three more chances for that input."
