

# Disability Rights Wisconsin: Governor Evers announces intent to redesignate client assistance program

Yesterday Governor Evers [announced](#) his intent to redesignate the Client Assistance Program (CAP) from the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP), to Disability Rights Wisconsin (DRW).

Disability Rights Wisconsin is the state's designated Protection and Advocacy system (P&A), with [programs](#) dedicated to protecting the rights of people with disabilities. The CAP is a natural fit, and in fact, is designated in most states with the P&A.
