

DNC: Democrats deliver as Republicans double down on extremism and obstruction

The contrast between the Democratic and Republican parties couldn't be clearer – and it's getting uglier by the day for the GOP. Take Virginia for example, where we saw gubernatorial candidate Glenn Youngkin tighten his embrace of Donald Trump as the former president headlined a rally in support of his campaign that included attendees using a flag present at the January 6 insurrection during the pledge of allegiance. Trump's full throated endorsement of Youngkin just hours after reiterating his belief that the "Presidential Election Fraud of 2020" is the most important issue facing the country is just the latest embrace between Trump and Youngkin, who said earlier in his campaign that "Trump represents so much of why I'm running."
