Social distancing and mask wearing will be required both indoors and outdoors at all times.

Proceed to the guest services desk on the main floor and wait to be escorted by a staff member to the appropriate location.

Members of the media are also reminded that the vaccine site will be open and operational. Individuals arriving at Lambeau Field to receive their vaccine are entitled to privacy. Please do not capture photos or videos of people that would allow them to be identified. Social distancing and mask wearing will be required both indoors and outdoors at all times. Anyone who is feeling ill or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 is asked to stay home.
