

# Jagler campaign: Endorsed by Dodge County Sheriff and District Attorney

**Watertown** – Dodge County Sheriff Dale Schmidt and District Attorney Kurt Klomberg announced today they are endorsing John Jagler in the race to represent the 13th Senate District in Madison.
