

Jagler campaign: Joint Finance Co-Chair Mark Born endorses Jagler for Senate

Watertown – Today, Rep. Mark Born (R-Beaver Dam) announced his endorsement of John Jagler to represent the 13th Senate District in Madison.

“John and I were elected to the State Assembly in the same year and have worked together to improve the lives of everyone in Wisconsin,” said Born. “I can’t think of anyone better to represent me and my family in the 13th Senate District.”

Born was appointed this session as Co-Chair of the budget-writing Joint Finance Committee. “I know John has the conservative credentials to help me continue to improve Wisconsin.
