

Leaders of Kenosha: Activists demanding justice for Jacob Blake respond to local mass shooting

In response to [Sunday's shooting](#) at a Kenosha County tavern, Tanya Mclean, executive director of local activist group Leaders of Kenosha, said:

“We are past ‘last straws’, and we are past piecemeal solutions that do nothing to keep us safe. There’s been [more than one mass shooting per day](#) in 2021, and we’ve heard nothing from the Biden administration. Bold government action is the only thing that will stop the senseless violence we saw in Kenosha, Austin and Indianapolis this weekend. We’re done begging — Biden and Congress need to side with the majority of Americans who want life-saving gun control and pass these policies immediately. Our hearts and actions are with the families of Kevin Donaldson, Cedric Gaston and Atkeen Stevenson, and we implore our elected lawmakers to stand with us.”
