MILWAUKEE, WI – Alderwoman Chantia Lewis on Wednesday announced her candidacy for U.S. Senate in the state of Wisconsin. Flipping the swing seat, currently held by Republican Senator Ron Johnson, is critical to holding and expanding Democrats' majority in Congress.
