## Lt. Gov. Mandela Barnes Statement on Ron Johnson's Vote Against Bipartisan Infrastructure Legislation

**MADISON**— Lieutenant Governor Mandela Barnes released the following statement blasting Ron Johnson's vote against the bipartisan infrastructure bill and highlighting the need to invest in Wisconsin's working families:

*"Today, Ron Johnson voted 'no' to bipartisan legislation that would build critical infrastructure, 'no' to good-paying jobs for working class Wisconsinites, and 'no' to investments in the 21st century economy. This 'no' sends a clear signal that Ron Johnson has no interest in delivering for the people of Wisconsin.*
