

NRSC: Hypocrite landlord Alex Lasry

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Washington, D.C. - According to the [Daily Caller](#), spoiled rich kid and WI Dem Senate candidate Alex Lasry made as much as \$100,000 in rental income as an [advocate](#) for the continuation of the pandemic eviction moratorium.

The Daily Caller wrote, "The Democratic candidate received between \$50,001 and \$100,000 in rental income on a New York City condo he owned, according to his candidate financial report showing his income between Jan. 1, 2020 and May 12, 2021.
