

# Rep. Conley: Applauds Gov. Evers' investments in education

MADISON - Today, Governor Tony Evers allocated \$110 million for school funding through federal coronavirus relief funds. The funding will be distributed on a per-pupil basis of \$133.72 per pupil. Sue Conley (D-Janesville) released the following statement:
