While families are suffering Governor Evers continues to play politics rather than take responsibility for his lack of leadership. [According to the nonpartisan Legislative Audit Bureau](#), from March 15, 2020 through June 30, 2020, a mere **.5% of all calls placed to the DWD unemployment call center were answered.**
