

# Rep. Neylon: Supreme court finds Evers administration abused emergency powers again

Pewaukee — Today Rep. Adam Neylon (R-Pewaukee) issued the following statement in response to the Wisconsin Supreme Court opinion on *Fabick v. Evers*:

“Today’s Supreme Court opinion is a win for our civil liberties and confirms Governor Evers’ administration continually overstepped their authority.
