

Rep. Shelton: Praises Gov. Evers' \$110m investment in public schools

GREEN BAY - Today, Governor Tony Evers announced a \$110 million investment in schools across our state, to the tune of an additional \$133.72 per pupil to each school. These funds will be given to schools without strings attached, to be used in the best interest of students by each individual school district. In response to this investment, Representative Shelton offered this statement:

This funding comes as a follow up to the passage of our state's budget, where Republicans on the Joint Finance Committee sought to barely achieve the maintenance-of-effort standard required to receive federal coronavirus support dollars. "From this investment, the Green Bay Area Schools District will receive \$2,770,371 to enhance our children's education.
