MADISON - Today, Senate Republicans moved multiple bills forward affecting Wisconsin's sporting heritage, despite the bewilderment from sportsmen and women and conservation organizations.

Sen. Jeff Smith (D - Brunswick) released the following statement in response to the Senate floor period:
