Right now, premiums are significantly lower through the American Rescue Plan, which was passed by Democrats in Congress and signed into law by President Biden in March. In Wisconsin, there are approximately 212,000 adults who may be eligible for premium tax credits and 146,000 of whom may be able to find a plan at HealthCare.gov for \$50 per month or less.
