PRAIRIE DU CHIEN, WI – In his first quarter of fundraising for his 2022 campaign for Wisconsin's 3rd Congressional District, Derrick Van Orden raised over \$750,000. A massive fundraising haul for the challenger who gave Ron Kind his closest election in a decade.
