Growing up in a single-parent home in Milwaukee as one of six children, White began college at 16. He earned his Bachelor of Arts in Communication Arts and Afro-American Studies from the University of Wisconsin-Madison at 20 years old and was a PEOPLE and Chancellor’s Scholar.

White also lived in Mombasa, Kenya, helping fight the HIV/AIDS pandemic as a volunteer at Alicia Keys’ Keep a Child Alive campaign’s BOMU Medical Center. It was an experience that forever changed White’s world perspective.
