Wisconsin Parents Blast Senator Johnson for Standing Against Tax Cut for Wisconsin Families

Green Bay, Wis. — Today, Green Bay parents Dr. Kristin Lyerly and Terry Lee blasted Senator Ron Johnson's opposition to the Child Tax Credit, a tax cut that will benefit Wisconsin families.
