[Madison, WI] – Today, Empower Wisconsin [reported](#) that Milwaukee County residents have filed an official complaint asking for the removal of Milwaukee County District Attorney John Chisholm, who admitted that his office’s bail recommendation for Darrell Brooks was “inappropriately low.” While calls for Chisholm’s [ouster](#) have mounted, Tony Evers has [refused](#) to let Wisconsinites know where he stands on the issue.

The Republican Party of Wisconsin released the following statement from Executive Director Mark Jefferson:
