MADISON — For the second quarter in a row Lt. Governor Mandela Barnes raised far and away the most money in the Democratic primary and once again outraised nearly the entire primary field combined.

- **\$43.65** average donation
- **17,830** total donors
- **27,252** individual donations
- **Not one dime** in Corporate PAC money
- No self-funding
