Their son, Elijah, was diagnosed with a condition (BOO) at the 16th week ultrasound that gave him a nearly impossible chance of survival after being born. Termination was recommended several times by doctors throughout their pregnancy, but Ty & Paige held true to their beliefs and told their doctors that termination was not an option and that it was all in God's hands. Ty and Paige feel blessed to have had that hour with their son and they know they will see him again someday.

Over the last three years, Ty has worked for the Department of Corrections, serving at both Kettle Moraine Correctional Institution and Taycheedah Correctional Institution. Ty serves as the Board Chairman of Cristo Rey Ranch in Mt. Calvary, which is an organization that specializes in animal therapy for children and young adults with intellectual disabilities.
