

# City of Madison Clerk: In-person absentee voting begins tomorrow

MADISON, WI – In-person absentee voting will begin tomorrow, Tuesday, July 26, at [several locations](#) throughout the City of Madison.

What will you need to bring with you if you're voting absentee in person?

- An acceptable photo ID for voting in Wisconsin.
- If you need to register for the first time or update your registration because of a move or name change, you will need to bring a proof of residence document with you, too.

Because we have multiple ballot styles citywide, we use the ExpressVote accessible ballot-marking device for in-person absentee voting.

Voters who have requested an absentee ballot by mail can return their completed absentee ballot to an in-person absentee voting location during the location's voting hours. During in-person absentee voting in the City of Madison, voters returning their mailed absentee ballot must return their ballot to an in-person absentee voting site, not the City of Madison Clerk's Office.

Voters who have moved since the last time they voted may also register to vote at any in-person absentee voting location. Voters need to have moved to the address where they are registering on or before July 12. They also need to present an acceptable proof of residence document with their current name and their current address listed. Acceptable proof of residence examples can be found on the [City](#)

At the end of the voting shift for the day, your absentee ballot will be brought to the Clerk's Office in a courier bag with a tamper-evident seal. The unique serial number on the tamper-evident seal is documented on a chain-of-custody form, as is the number of absentee envelopes sealed in the courier bag.
