Members of the public may choose to view and/or provide comment in person or virtually at hybrid Council meetings.

ATTENDING and VIEWING HYBRID COMMON COUNCIL MEETINGS

Hybrid Common Council meetings will be held in-person at City-County Building Room 201 and on the City's Zoom meeting platform.

Council meetings will still be viewable live and on-demand via Madison City Channel, the City website and the City's YouTube channel.

To attend or give public comment in person, enter through the main doors at 210

Martin Luther King Jr Blvd and proceed to Level 2. Currently, Dane County's COVID-19 Community Level is Medium. The Council will be following COVID-19 guidelines from Public Health Madison and Dane County. Masks are recommended, but not required. You can find additional recommendations for the Medium level on PHMDC's site.

To give public comment virtually, register online and you will be sent an email with the information you will need to join the virtual meeting.
