

Democratic Governors Association: Trouble in MAGA land? Michels campaigns with DeSantis but not Trump

As Donald Trump announces rallies with Republicans across the country, he's notably left Wisconsin and Tim Michels [off the list](#), an embarrassing snub for Michels, who's groveled for Trump's support throughout his campaign.

Michels has, however, campaigned with Trump's [bitter rival](#) Ron DeSantis. As DeSantis neglects his own state to elevate his national profile, he's dragged Michels into the [ongoing feud](#) between the two likely presidential hopefuls.

snubbing Michels because he's salty about him campaigning with DeSantis? As the MAGA wing of the GOP self implodes, this embarrassing lack of unity shows that Michels is on the rocks in these final weeks."
