**MADISON, Wis.** – The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) will hold a virtual public meeting and comment period regarding plans for the observation tower at Potawatomi State Park at 4 p.m. on Jan. 27.

The observation tower is currently closed to the public due to safety concerns. The DNR is committed to finding a path forward. The department understands the complexities of this project from the varying options for repair, to the historical significance and the desire and requirement of accessibility.
