

# Evers campaign: Announces new ad on Tim Michels' radical position on abortion

MADISON, Wis. — Today, Governor Tony Evers' campaign launched a new ad highlighting Tim Michels' radical position on abortion. Tim Michels has reiterated time and time again that his abortion stance reflects Wisconsin's 1849 abortion ban, which includes no exceptions for rape, incest, or health of the mother.

Gov. Evers wants to protect access to abortion, because it is healthcare. Gov.
