MADISON, Wis. — On Monday, Governor Tony Evers received the endorsement of the Wisconsin Laborers District Council at their training center in DeForest and spoke on the importance of job training programs and apprenticeships.



The training center Gov. Evers visited has eight classrooms and four training bays for hands-on learning — and it trains around 2,000 men and women annually on skills like concrete, demolition, welding, and much more. Training programs like this are crucial to growing our workforce and filling jobs across our state. Gov. Evers believes we need to make sure every Wisconsinite knows about and has access to these incredible opportunities.
