

Foreign Policy for America: Endorses Deb McGrath (WI-03) for election

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WASHINGTON D.C. – [Foreign Policy for America](#) announced today its endorsement of Deb McGrath for election to the U.S. House of Representatives. McGrath is a foreign policy expert; she has served in the sector for 25 years, first in the Army and later as a national security officer at the State Department and the CIA.
