MADISON - Today, **State Treasurer and candidate for U.S. Senate Sarah Godlewski** slammed Ron Johnson for refusing to protect women's reproductive rights as the U.S. Senate tried and failed to pass Senator Tammy Baldwin's *Women's Health Protection Act*.
