MADISON - Today, a new independent public poll commissioned by Marquette University Law School showed that the Wisconsin Primary Senate race remains wide open as 36% of voters remain undecided. Meanwhile, Godlewski leads Ron Johnson in a head-to-head match-up at 45% to 43%
