

Godlewski campaign: Wisconsin Senate Debate - Godlewski to show she's the best candidate to take on Ron Johnson in November

MILWAUKEE - This evening, **State Treasurer and candidate for U.S. Senate Sarah Godlewski** will take the stage and deliver a clear message to Wisconsin Democratic primary voters: Sarah is the best candidate to take on Ron Johnson in November.

Since the Supreme Court overturned *Roe v. Wade*, Sarah has seen a surge in momentum, including the [best 72-hour stretch](#) of individual donations of her campaign and a strong performance in the straw poll conducted at the Democratic Party of Wisconsin Convention which showed she is "[effectively tied](#)" with frontrunner Mandela Barnes. The Supreme Court ruling is clearly shaking up this race, and as the only woman running, Sarah has been a leading voice since her campaign began last spring.

With over three weeks to go until the August 9th primary, it's clear this race is still wide open: the [most recent independent public poll](#) showed 36% of voters remain undecided, and Godlewski leads Ron Johnson in a head-to-head match-up at 45% to 43%. The campaign also reported two back-to-back best fundraising quarters, fueled by Godlewski's rise to the forefront as she fights to protect reproductive rights.

In addition to sounding the alarm on threats to reproductive rights, Sarah has prioritized the kitchen table issues that keep hardworking Wisconsinites up at night by releasing policy plans to address these issues in the Senate:
