MADISON — Gov. Tony Evers announced today that he is seeking applicants for the Washington County Circuit Court-Branch 1. The appointment will fill a vacancy being created by Judge James G. Poulos' resignation, effective June 3, 2022. The new judge will complete a term ending July 31, 2023.
