

# Jarchow campaign: Announces over two dozen legislative endorsements

[Balsam Lake, Wis.] – Today, Adam Jarchow announced the support of over two dozen conservative legislative leaders in his campaign for attorney general. The leaders – representing districts in all regions of the state – cited Adam’s conservative bonafides and record of fighting back against the extreme liberal politicians and bureaucratic deep state.
