WEST ALLIS, WI — Jessica Katzenmeyer (D), who is running for the U.S. House of Representatives in Wisconsin's 5th Congressional District, has released a video statement reflecting on the one-year anniversary of the January 6th attack on the U.S. Capitol. Another four were killed later by suicide and over 140 officers were injured. Senator Ron Johnson lied to us saying this was largely a peaceful protest knowing the violence that was happening outside.
