

# Kleefisch campaign: Applauds Legislature for stopping illegal ballot curing rule

[Waukesha, Wis.] — Candidate for governor Rebecca Kleefisch released the following statement on Wednesday after the Joint Committee for the Review of Administrative Rules stopped an emergency rule issued by the Wisconsin Elections Commission to allow clerks to cure ballots:
